

Propylene Glycol Content - a compound that mixes completely and evenly with water and dissolves in many essential oils. It is used in the humidification of tobacco products

Glycerol Content - a sweet colorless liquid, glycerol acts as a humectant when added to tobacco form, helping to retain moisture in the product

Menthol Content – an organic compound made synthetically or obtained from peppermint or other mint oils. Added to produce a cool sensation in the throat when vapor is inhaled

Nicotine Content – a colorless, oily chemical found in tobacco that makes people physically dependent on smoking

The following results of components with amounts < 0.1% is untraceable which indicates component may or may not be present.

Linalool Content - a naturally occurring compound found in many flowers and spice plants with many commercial applications, the majority of which are based on its pleasant scent (floral, with a touch of spiciness). ...

Ethanol Content - natural gas that is produced from corn

Beta and Alpha Ionone Content - ionones are part of a group of compounds known as rose ketones, Ionones are aroma compounds found in a variety of essential oils, including rose oil. ...
